- 📍 Open to Year 11 and 12 students

Students will gain useful insights into the daily functions within a police station and will learn specifically about customer service, judicial process, brief of evidence and other administration tasks. Students will visit the prosecutors court and Victoria Police Training Centre.

Students participating in this program will be provided with a dedicated mentor who will provide support and guidance as well as feedback during the placement.

Each student will also receive a Victoria Police watermarked certificate, letter of support and/or reference from their mentor which can be added to their employment portfolio.
